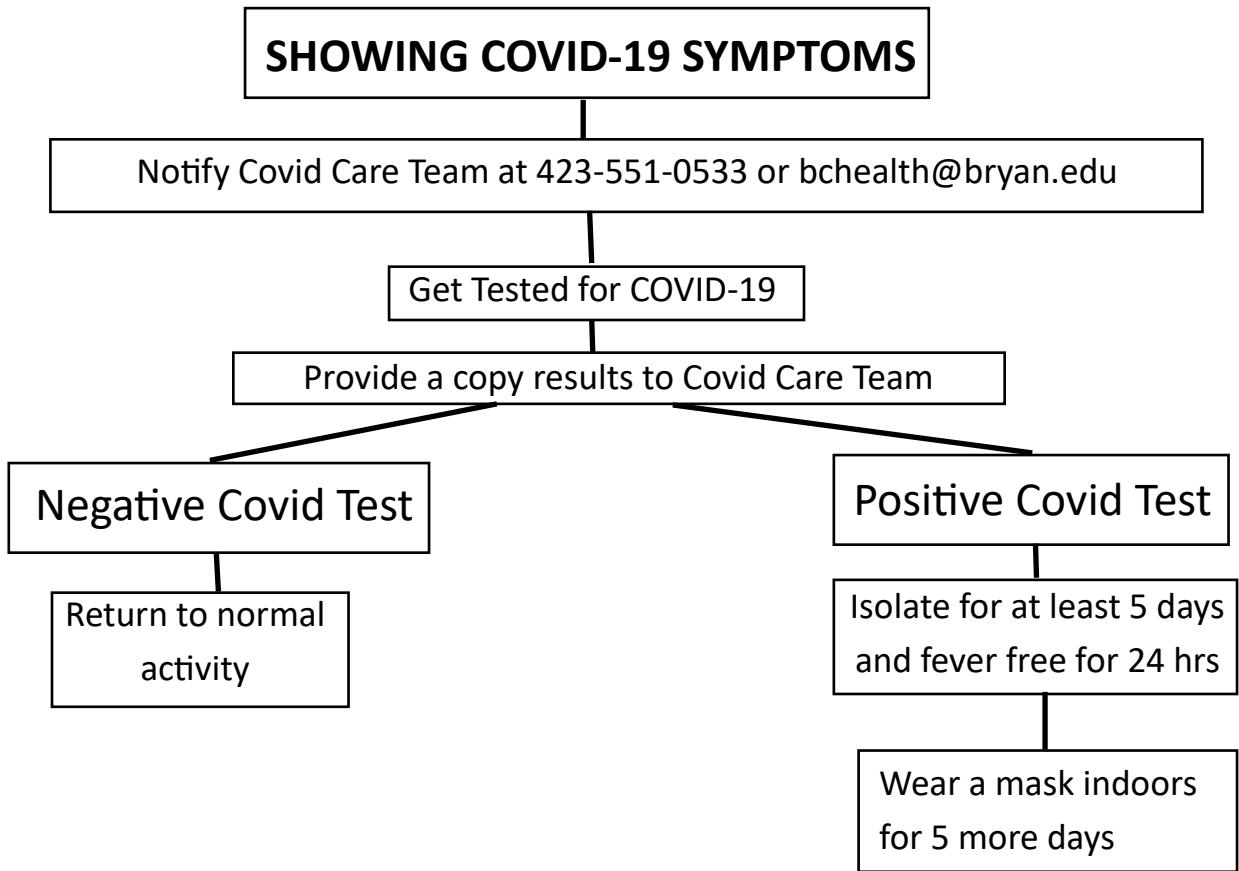


COVID-19 Guidelines

Persons who have developed symptoms consistent with COVID-19, **regardless of vaccination status**, are required to return home or go into designated quarantine quarters until a COVID test has been performed and the results filed with the Covid Care Team.

Symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are as follows (2 or more): dry cough, fever, tiredness, loss of taste or smell, aches and pains, headache, sore throat, nasal congestion



COVID-19 Proximity Guidelines (close contact)

These guidelines apply to persons who have been in close proximity (within 6ft. for 15 or more minutes) of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 2 days. In general, those who have been in close proximity will be required to quarantine away from others for the periods of time indicated below.

NOTE: Persons who start showing COVID-19 symptoms at any time should immediately enter the COVID-19 Symptoms protocol listed above.
