Bryan College administers the ETS Proficiency Profile to both freshmen and senior students to measure student achievement in relation to the effectiveness of the College's general education curriculum.

Bryan College's minimal threshold for this senior percentile on this student achievement measure is $50 \%$ (92\% achieved). EXCEEDED

Bryan College's goal is to increase student achievement by raising the mean senior score, versus freshmen from the same incoming class, by 5 points ( 17.65 mean achieved). EXCEEDED
