Placement in ENG 111 requires an ACT *English* score of at least 21 *OR* an SAT Evidence-Based Reading & Writing score of at least 530 *OR* CLT score of at least 68. Students who are placed in the ENG 109-110 sequence will need to take ENG 110 in the spring semester of the freshman year.
