NEW YORK/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5

Your exciting adventure begins as you arrive Venice. Built on 118 small islands lying some four kilometers from the mainland, Venetian highways are made of water and the islands are linked by numerous and picturesque bridges. Upon arrival in Venice, transfer to your hotel on the mainland. (D)

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 6

Enjoy your morning walking tour of Venice Island beginning with a visit to the Byzantine Basilica San Marco situated on the eastern end of St. Mark's Square. See the Palace of the Doges, the Bridge of Sighs, and the Rialto. The afternoon is at leisure to explore this captivating city on your own. (B,D)

VENICE/FLORENCE

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 7

Today's drive takes you through the serene Tuscan countryside to Florence, the cradle of Renaissance Art

and former stronghold of the infamous Medici family. From Botticelli to Da Vinci, the city is unsurpassed in art treasures and the glory of its history. Upon arrival your walking tour includes the Piazza della Signoria, where the Neptune Fountain stands, the Duomo, the Baptistry with its "Gates of Paradise" doors and Giotto's Bell Tower. Stop at Piazzale Michelangelo for a panoramic view of the city and the Arno Valley before arriving at your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

FLORENCE/SIENA AREA

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8

This morning visit the Academia housing Michelangelo's original statue of David. Free time to shop along the famous Ponte Vecchio and explore other Florentine delights before driving to mystical Siena, a showplace of Italian Gothic with roots planted to the Middle Ages. During your leisure time in Siena, stop in the Basilica of St. Dominic where you will find relics of St. Catherine. Walk to the piazza Il Campo where equestrians compete in the annual Palio (Parade of the Banner) and the 334-foot-high tower of the town hall, Torre del Mangia or wander to the magnificent Duomo with its striped façade and ornate interior. Spend the night in the Siena area. (B,D)

SIENA AREA/SORRENTO AREA

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9

Continue your journey as you travel south today through the well-tilled fields and orchards of the Neapolitan countryside. Continue along the magnificent coastline to the cliff-top town of Sorrento. Overnight in the Sorrento area. (B,D)

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 10

Today's scenery is breathtaking as you travel along the magnificent Amalfi coastline. Sheer cliffs and hillsides, olive, lemon and orange trees and spectacular views of the Mediterranean make this one of Italy's greatest treasures. Return to Sorrento where you will see a wood carving display (Intarsia). Free time to stroll about or shop for fine linens and ceramics. **(B,D)**

SORRENTO AREA/POMPEII/ROME

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 11

Depart this morning for Pompeii, a city destroyed by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in the year 79 A.D. Visit the excavations where the life of 20 centuries ago comes alive with its incredibly preserved temples, baths, theaters and many dwellings.

Follow the Autostrada del Sole speedway across Roman countryside enroute to the unforgettable and Eternal City of Rome. Located in the center of the Region of Lazio, Rome is a reflection of every era. The wonders of Rome surround you...a world of art, history and culture that has been attracting visitors since the beginning of Western civilization. **(B)**

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12

Your sightseeing tour this morning takes you to Vatican City. See the wonderful art treasures in the Vatican
